

Kentucky Race Track Chaplain (KRTC)– Job Description

The Kentucky Race Track Chaplaincy is seeking an individual to fulfill the position of Chaplain at Turfway Park, in Florence Kentucky. The successful candidate will possess the following skills and qualifications:

Ministerial Requirements:

Individual should possess a Bachelor's degree or greater in religious studies.

- Ordained, licensed, or certified in the ministry by a recognized authority and legally qualified to perform weddings.
- Meet the spiritual, emotional, physical, social/educational and recreational needs of the personnel associated with KRTC racetracks.
- Hold a weekly nondenominational chapel service, conduct Bible studies and establish other religious gatherings and activities.
- Must be qualified to function as counselor, social worker, pastor and friend to all personnel of the race track.
- Agree to work within the policies and guidelines established by the State Racing Commissioners, race track management, horsemen's organizations and the KRTC Council.

Physical Requirements:

- Walk the barn area during working hours of race track personnel.
- Establish and maintain regular office hours.

Communication Requirements:

- Communicate weekly with members of the industry including, but not limited to, track management, security, Commonwealth racing commissioners, starting gate crew, horsemen's organizations and the stable office.
- Coordinate with the Recreation Director assigned by the Racetrack Board of Ministry to establish regular recreational and educational projects.
- Provide reporting to the KRTC council as required.
- Visit churches, civic organizations and clubs to build relationships within the community.
- Maintain financial records for his/her area of responsibility.

Other duties as may be assigned by the KRTC council.
